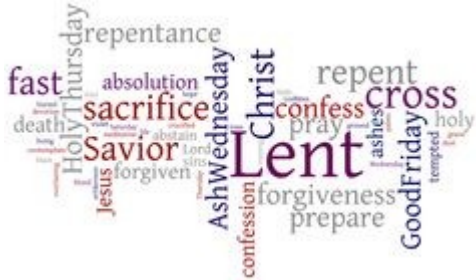


Palm Sunday, March 29th, marks Jesus’s joyful, humble entry into Jerusalem on a donkey, celebrated by people waving palm branches as a sign of respect, love, and victory. It kicks off Holy Week, the final week of Lent, as a reminder for kids to welcome Jesus into their hearts, acknowledging him as a loving King.



Lent is a special 40-day season (not counting Sundays) before Easter when Christians prepare for the holiday by remembering Jesus' time in the desert. It begins on Ash Wednesday and is a time for reflection, prayer, giving up treats (fasting), and helping others, symbolizing a fresh start and closeness to God. Ways You Can Observe Lent:

- Pray daily: Spend time talking to God.
- Give up a treat: Choose to skip a favorite sweet or activity.
- Help others: Do extra chores or share with someone in need.
- Read Bible stories: Focus on the stories of Jesus.
